REDEDICATION OF LITERACY ROOM

About five years ago the club donated several thousand dollars to the Literacy Council of Williamson County to equip the literacy room located on the 2nd floor of the library. Tommi Urbanski was an active literacy trainer and tutor, and one of the few Paul Harris members that our club has recognized who was not a member. She was also a Round Rock Citizen of the Year.

Tommi passed away last year. Over the year, over \$2000 was donated in her name. It was decided to do a memorial for her with the funds that were donated.

The literacy room in the library has been renamed the Tommi Urbanski Literacy Learning Center, and will be rededicated September 9 at 3:00 pm as part of the National Literacy Day activities taking place on Friday and Saturday. All club members are invited as funds donated for Paul Harris were used to equip the room the first time. A metal Rotary emblem will be placed on the wall as well.

Take a look at the wall in progress which has gone from white to red, is getting nice calligraphic lettering, and will sport pictures and a portrait of Tommi.
