## LOOKING FOR AN OUTBOUND STUDENT, HOST CLUB

The district has announced an October 31 deadline for applications from high school students wishing to study overseas for a year. The youth should be between 15 and 18 1/2 on August 1 of the year he/she goes out. The applicant should be a good student and healthy in body and mind. The club will interview the student using district-provided forms. If the club approves the student, the youth will complete the long form, provide information related to grades through their high school, and have a medical check up. The club form and the long form is due to the committee ON October 31.

Don't have a student in mind? Host families are also needed for 2007-2008. While families with teens are preferred, active older adults who can provide an environment that involves activities for youth (encourage school extracurricular activities, religious activities, travel) could work. And, the club has to decide to want to host a youth, too. There are some fiscal implications.
